### **Judicial Context and Critical Analysis**

He is currently serving a 159-year prison sentence for the death of a teenager. From the beginning of the process, he maintains his innocence and upholds a position of clear conscience regarding the charges brought against him.

This section does not seek to replace courts or issue parallel judgments.

It seeks to open space for critical reflection.

### **Elements of the Process**

During the trial, the central testimony used by the prosecution comes from an individual who states that he was not present at the scene of the crime. His version is based on information received from third parties and on an alleged later confession attributed to the accused.

There is no direct statement of having witnessed the act.

There is no claim of having seen the weapon.

There is no confirmation of having been at the location of the events.

Additionally, another witness voluntarily requests to testify that the primary witness confessed to fabricating the account. This testimony is not admitted into the proceedings.

At the appellate stage, one court grants favorable determinations. Subsequently, the process at a higher judicial level faces procedural deficiencies related to legal representation.

Months after issuing the sentence, the judge who imposed it takes his own life.

These facts do not constitute an alternative verdict.

They constitute context.

## **Legal and Human Reflection**

The purpose of this section is not to declare guilt or innocence from a digital platform. The purpose is to raise questions that deserve deep analysis:

Can a life sentence be sustained on indirect testimony?

Where does reasonable doubt begin, and where does it end?

Should public opinion form without examining complete case records?

Can any judicial system be entirely free from human error?

Is it responsible to reduce an entire life to a single narrative?

José does not demand media absolution.

He demands that people think.

### **Personal Position**

On the day of sentencing, José publicly states that he prefers to remain in prison with a clear conscience rather than accept guilt that does not belong to him in exchange for freedom.

That statement is not intended as dramatization.

It is intended as an ethical position.

Would you choose freedom under a false admission?

Or would you maintain your version even in the face of maximum consequence?

Your reflection is not insignificant.

Collective consciousness is built through responsible analysis.
